This is an invitational letter for your child to apply to our Specialist High Skills Major program in Health & Wellness: Health Care / Health Promotion.

Specialist High Skills Major programs allow students to focus on a career path that matches their skills and interests while meeting the requirements of the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).

Students receive the SHSM seal on their diploma when they:

- complete a specific bundle of 8-10 courses during grades 11&12 in the student's selected pathway
- relate course work to the health industry by completing contextualized learning activities (CLAs)
- earn valuable industry certifications including First Aid/CPR, Infection Control, etc
- gain important on-the-job skills with employers through 2 or 4 credit Coop placements.

The program is especially appealing to all students who:

- enjoy hands-on, focussed learning
- are interested in exploring a future in the health care sector
- like to network with employers & build skills in the sector before graduating from high school.

During the SHSM program, our students will:

- see the connections between their studies, the world beyond high school and future careers
- develop essential skills and work habits required in the workplace
- gain valuable work experience that will build a resume for post-secondary programs and future employment.
