The volunteer opportunities for the students are as follows:

1. Wednesday October 23 - The Haunting, 4:30-11pm - dress up and scare people! The Haunting is a community event hosted by the DOMB (Downtown Orillia Management Board). Ticketed guests receive guided tours/haunted walk through the downtown as well as at the museum.
2. Tour Guides - 2 hours on a Saturday or Sunday, ongoing - students sit in the galleries, greet guests, answer questions about the exhibitions and/or give tours of the building. Great opportunity to develop transferrable skills, improve communication skills and gain knowledge in the visual arts, art history, and community history.
3. Family Fun Sundays - 2 hours, 1:30-3:30 - Studio Assistant - help set up and clean up, prepare materials, work with children and families, learn art history
4. March Break Camp - 11am-2pm, up to 5 shifts - Studio Assistant - help set up and clean up, prepare materials, work with children, learn art history
