**Can I still receive this award if I choose a non-related program?**

*Award is associated with related programs as the SHSM certificate demonstrates an interest and preparedness for this field of study for incoming students*

**Can I pass the award on to anyone else such as a friend?**

*No, the Scholarship is non-transferrable.*

A committee will review the applications and select a recipient based on the responses to the question.

The SHSM Scholarship will be applied to the recipient's student account by August 3rd, 2019. This Scholarship can be combined with other Trent University Scholarships.

**To Be Eligible**

- You must receive the Specialist High Skills Major seal on your secondary school diploma.
- You must be a new incoming student directly from high school.
- You must be registered full-time for the 2019-2020 academic year at Trent University in Peterborough or Durham.
- The SHSM scholarship is non-refundable and non-transferrable and cannot be deferred to a different year.

If you have completed a Specialist High Skills Major as part of your Ontario Secondary School Diploma you can apply for this scholarship through your myTrent portal by answering this question:

How did your Specialist High Skills Major help prepare you for Trent University?

In 1000 words or less, explain how completing a SHSM will help you to be successful as you pursue your degree.

The deadline to apply is Friday, June 30, 2019.

**Arts and Culture**, Business, **Health and Wellness**, Non-profit, Sports, Justice and Community Safety.

The SHSM award is a one-time award valued at \$2,000; no application required. Students must have an 78% admission average as calculated by Brescia's Admissions Office, and be entering full-time studies for the 2019-2020 academic year. The SHSM award may be held in conjunction with a Brescia Entrance Scholarship.
